40th Anniversary Year



It came to our attention, during a presentation to a Brownie troop on a November evening, that Birthcare has been in existence 40 years! A second grader asked how long Birthcare has been around. So we did the math aloud! It was founded in 1976 by two nurses, Collette Krantz and Celestia Gaudreault, who saw a need to help pregnant young women and families with young children. Past directors of the agency include Palma Horsley, June

Kaspar, Susan Mayes, Sally Pap and Marita Tulisiak. Our current site is the third location in the agency's history. A working board was instituted in 2007. Current director, Barbara McCoy, began volunteering back in 1990 with Birthcare and was hired as executive director in January, 2010. Current asst. director/treasurer Diane Bugner assumed her role in Spring, 1988. We are grateful to those who made our progress as an organization possible.

Who Turns to Birthcare?

Each week Birthcare is privileged to help families caring for young children.

Who turns to Birthcare for daily survival assistance?

- a single mom of twins unable to work because she must stay home to care for one twin with cancer
- a grandparent given custody of two grandchildren whose mother is in jail due to drugs
- a young pregnant teen, kicked out of her home by parent, has no job, no means of support
- three Amish families: one family of 11 children (four with special needs); another family of 7 children; and one family of six children. Volunteer Sue

Faeking visits them monthly to bring diapers, formula, baby food, books, clothing, shampoo and blankets.

- a single mom whose ex-husband stopped paying child support

Client Report

Through 11 months, we served 319 client families on 1,186 office visits (16% increase in visits over 2015! We met:

- 851 requests for infant clothing
- 302 requests for infant formula
- 93 requests for baby food
- 1,252 requests for diapers
- 24 requests for car seats
- 26 requests for cribs / 24 requests for mattresses

The collection was in response to National Diaper Need Awareness Week.

The **Medina Noon Kiwanis** delivered \$650 worth of much needed formula, baby food, baby wash, diapers and wipes in November.

A group of Brownies from **St. Francis Xavier Parish, Troop #91069**,



recently visited us bearing gifts they collected and stayed to tour our office and find out what we do. Executive Director Barb McCoy and Asst. Director Diane Bugner hosted the 14 young ladies and their leaders, Beth Bugner, Kara Bethany and Natalie Boothe. Rounding out their visit, they tied together two fleece



blankets cut out by volunteer Sister Sandy Bevec. We loved their bubbly enthusiasm and willingness to help others! The **Medina Eagles Ladies Auxiliary** hosted a Quarter Auction this month and proceeds of \$500 were presented to



Birthcare. Executive Director Barb McCoy accepted the donation at the evening meeting and event.

Marian Getz, an eighth grader at St. Francis Xavier School, Medina, donated 10% of her pillow sales from a craft show. Her business is aptly named Sew Soft and Sweet. This is the second year she has taken the initiative in donating proceeds from sales in order to "help those in need of support or supplies."

Other significant donations included a diaper drive by **St. Francis Xavier Respect Life Ministry**; a **St. Ambrose Fill A Crib** program that collected money and needed diapers, clothing, pajamas, baby food, baby wash, bottles, sheets and towels totaling \$800. We were given several handmade crib blankets, hats, scarves and gloves

from the annual **Warm-Up Medina County** drive which produced more than 736 items distributed to more than a dozen county agencies.

Holy Martyrs Seniors Group, comprised of more than 60 members met before Thanksgiving, hand-tied 17 fleece blankets for Birthcare, collected new and many beautiful hand-made items at a baby shower for Birthcare which included winter clothing, diapers, fleece pajamas and jackets, mittens, gloves, hats, and then 20 came on a field trip to deliver their gifts. Board secretary and volunteer Joanne Weiler met the seniors, hosted a tour and helped them unload their donations which covered two six-foot tables and lots of floor space!
